

Promotions Committee College of Engineering

Structure of the Committee: the committee will be comprised of one full professor from the academic departments in the College of Engineering, with one representative being a current chair of an academic department. The name of the department representative will be sent to the Office of the Dean prior to the end of April each year. As recommended by the CoE Leadership Council, the Dean has the authority to not accept the department's nomination. If such a case arises, the Dean will consult with the chair of the appropriate department to identify an alternate candidate. The position held by a current chair will rotate alphabetically by department, beginning in the 2017-18 academic year with the Department of Industrial and Systems Engineering.

Charge to the committee:

The Promotions Committee in the College of Engineering will advise the Dean on the following:

1. The progress of all assistant professors in the College of Engineering as demonstrated in their third-year review documents. The intent is to ensure the highest quality mentoring of assistant professors and assist them in succeeding. The Dean will communicate the comments of the Promotions Committee to the appropriate party, executive committee and or mentoring committee, through the department chair. For renewals in subsequent years, should the Dean not concur with the recommendation of the department, she/he will consult with the Promotions Committee and department prior to making a final decision.
2. The case for promotion from assistant to associate Professor with tenure. The committee will receive the promotion package of the candidate at the same time it is submitted to the Physical Sciences Divisional Committee or other appropriate Divisional Committee. The committee will provide a recommendation to the Dean independent of the recommendation from the Divisional Committee.
3. The case for promotion from associate to full Professor. The committee will receive the promotion package of the candidate prepared in accordance with the college guidelines for promotion from associate to professor package approved May, 2017. The committee will provide a recommendation to the Dean.
